• PROJECT SUMMARY •

"30 years of Maastricht: reflections on the past, present and future of Europe" is a project framed in the program CERV, promoted by Molėtų Rajono Savivaldybės administracija, as coordinator of the project and in cooperation with 8 partners from 7 different countries of the EU: Lithuania, Portugal, Bulgaria, Spain, Greece, France, Malta and Italy.

In line with the priorities of the CERV program and the European Commission, this project of Network of Towns, have as general objectives:

1. Encourage citizen participation in decision-making related to digitization and the future of the EU.
2. Promote digital rights and the protection of privacy and personal data of citizens of the European Union.
3. Analyse the impact of digitization on society and the economy of the European Union, including its effects on equality, diversity, and social cohesion.
4. Promote the understanding of European citizens about the Maastricht Treaty and its importance in European integration.

Since an event will be held in each one of the countries, the impact and visibility, as well as the program, will be fully guaranteed throughout the life of the project. 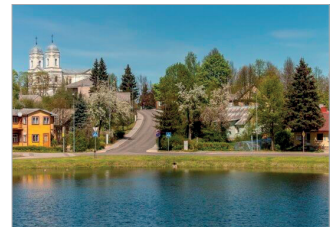
